Members, thanks to your swift and collective action, the GIC voted to reverse its January decision to drop 3 insurance plan choices from its program for next year. As a result, if you do not wish to make any changes you have no action to take. Those who are considering a change must do so, and have all paperwork submitted to the Haverhill Public Schools benefits office, by 4:00 PM on Wednesday, May 2nd, 2018.

On a related note, all members should know that there is no reason to delay in submitting for reimbursements for healthcare expenses from ProFlex, the city's Healthcare Reimbursement Arrangement manager. The decision to save your statements and receipts until you've met your deductible, out-of-pocket maximum, or accumulated any other qualified expenses or to submit them as you receive them is yours to make. If you were told otherwise, ProFlex has been informed of their error and should now be accepting and paying those claims correctly. Inform your building representative if this is not the case.
