We look forward to presenting the remaining proposals, including a living wage for all ESPs, at our next session.

Proposals Discussed:

- **♦** Tuition Reimbursement and more relevant professional development
- ♦ Increasing the number of ESPs in the district with minimum staffing at every building
- Protecting ESPs against involuntary transfers based on seniority
- **♦** Providing time for ESPs to meet and consult with other educators
- **♦** Allowing 15 sick days per year to be used for family illnesses (currently only 3!)
- Establishing sick time buy-back upon retirement
- Create a 26-pay period option like the Teacher unit now has
